Re: Parents' Cooperation for Smooth Traffic Flow for NTIL Examinations (SA1 2019)

BTTSAL would like to seek parents' cooperation in managing a smooth traffic flow at the examination centres during arrival and dismissal time. Parents are advised to park their vehicles at the nearby multi-storied or open carpark areas in the vicinity of the examination centres.

Please be informed that parking restriction lines are drawn to safeguard road space for safe and smooth traffic flow. Please note that motorists are **NOT** allowed to park at critical areas such as 3 metres within a fire-hydrant, 6 metres within a junction and 9 metres within a bus stop.

BTTSAL's personnel and/or school's security personnel would be deployed to control traffic movement during arrival and dismissal periods. They would be stationed at the school gate to advise parents **NOT** to park at specific locations and **NOT** to enter the school's premises at any given time. Parents are kindly requested to take directives without fail from above personnel.

Kindly adhere to the traffic cones or signages which would be placed to restrict vehicles from parking at specific locations.

I seek your understanding and fullest cooperation to facilitate the smooth conduct of the Examinations.
